SPIR method

The method is, in essence, a way of approaching reading through selective but profound learning exercises of the synthesis ideas from the read text.

The following steps are essential:

- (1) S (Survey) perceptual-mental Survey, with the general approach of text
- 2) P (Preview) anticipatory selection of what interests you;
- (3) I (Inview) in-depth look inside the text, with reflection on the essence of reading
- (4) R (Review) Review, revision of the content from the perspective of the in-depth elements followed by the structuring and notation of what was retained / learned from the reading performed
